The sixth Eve Rimmer Games will be held in Whakatane on 19,20,21 March 2010.

This will be another great weekend of fun aimed at a healthy combination of competition and enjoyment.

The enthusiasm of participants at each of the previous events further encourages us to keep the Eve Rimmer Games going as a national opportunity for the enjoyment and development of both current and future athletes with disabilities.

The inspiration for this event came from Eve's commitment to both sport and improving opportunities for people with disabilities.

Eve is one of New Zealand's most renowned athletes, a member of the New Zealand Sports Hall of Fame, holder of fifteen paralympic medals, eight of them Gold. She was also a staunch advocate for the rights of people with disabilities to participate fully within their community.

Eve's efforts were recognised with the Award of the British Empire Medal in 1973.

In 1990 Eve organised a sports tournament for athletes with disabilities to celebrate New Zealand's sesquicentennial. That event was the catalyst for many people to pursue successful and enjoyable sporting careers.

It was Eve's example and commitment which inspired the local community to organise the first Eve Rimmer Games in the year 2000 and they have been held every second year since.

The Eve Rimmer Games are intended for athletes of all abilities and have not only resulted in a number of international opportunities for successful athletes but have produced a number of medal winners and World Records. Since the Eve Rimmer Games in 2006 Mathew Lack, (see cover, front right) has competed in Games in Ireland and South Africa and brought home medals and world records.

But the Games are much more than a competition. They are also an opportunity for fun, socialising and exploring new opportunities.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

The Eve Rimmer Games Committee is offering three scholarships to athletes who participate in the Games 2010.

The aim of these scholarships is to identify potential high achievers and provide them with some financial support and encouragement to help further their aspirations.

LEVEL ONE: For those who have aspirations and potential to compete and achieve at international level.
One grant of \$500.

LEVEL TWO: For those who have aspirations and potential to compete and achieve at national level.
Two grants of \$250.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Application must be received on the official entry form.
2. The selected sport discipline must have recognised international or national benchmarks and competitions.
3. The applicant must present a clear plan to achieve and attend an international or national event.
4. The grant will not be transferable.
5. Successful scholarship winners are required to advise the Eve Rimmer Games Committee how they used the Scholarship within two months of use.
6. The performance and results achieved during the Games 2010 will be taken into account.
7. The Grants will be awarded at the closing ceremony of the Games 2010.
8. The Committee reserves the right not to make grants in the event there are no suitable applicants.
9. The Committee's decision is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
